CLINIC BASED INTENSIVE WRITING GROUP

Word By Mouth's Argument Analysis Writing Group is targeted at Year 9-12 students. It will run for 2 sessions per day over 2 days. The focus will be on developing interpretation of arguments (contention, context, persuasive techniques, reader impact etc) and then how to structure an argument analysis. The focus for the program is to develop complex analytical writing skills through a strong foundation of sentence writing.

This is a group program designed to develop children's writing skills in an explicit, systematic teaching approach that is motivating and fun.

The intervention approaches applied are informed by the latest evidence in research literature. Sentence writing is critical for students' academic success and is required across many subject areas throughout high school.
