



Text Analysis Skills

WRITING WORKSHOP FOR STUDENTS IN YEARS 9 - 12

CLINIC BASED – 1 SESSION ONLY

Word By Mouth's Text Analysis workshop will run for 2.5hrs on one day only. This will be a workshop focused on the structure of a text analysis and text comparison essay writing, encouraging students to use **appropriate sentence structure** including **linking phrases** and **comparative vocabulary**. There will also be a focus on how to **embed quotes** from a text. The group is targeted at year 9-12 students. Students will be encouraged to bring their 2024 texts with them to use.

This is a group program designed to develop children's writing skills in an explicit, systematic teaching approach that is motivating and fun.

The intervention approaches applied are informed by the latest evidence in research literature. Sentence writing is critical for students' academic success and is required across many subject areas throughout high school.
