INTENSIVE LITERACY PROGRAM

CLINIC BASED OR VIA TELEPRACTICE

Word By Mouth's Intensive Literacy Program is an individualised and highly structured program. It aims to develop literacy skills through an explicit, synthetic, systematic phonics (SSP) based teaching approach that is motivating and fun.

Two intensive options:

1. Full intensive; or
2. Half intensive (suitable for clients who have completed an intensive program in the past)

This program was devised by the directors of Word By Mouth with the purpose of the program to support students with Specific Learning Difficulties through an intensive service delivery model.

The underlying skills essential for literacy success are addressed and reinforced including sound letter knowledge (phonics), phonological awareness and auditory discrimination. Single word reading, spelling, text reading and text writing are also addressed using a variety of resources that fit the scope and sequence of an SSP approach.
